

This is a supplementary page for the MP3 audio lessons “*The born again rebellion against our Heavenly Father*”. This ancient Greek text is discussed in those audio lessons. In John chapter 3 Jesus did not tell Nicodemus that except we get “born again we cannot go to see Heaven when we die”. Their discussion was about God’s Kingdom government that will rule upon the Earth, of which Jesus was prophesied to rule over as the Supreme King. Jesus told Nicodemus that we need to be generated from above (“up-place” in the Greek) in order to perceive (understand, grasp, aware) what the Kingdom of God is, and to enter it eternally with Him. Below is the literal 1<sup>st</sup> century sacred Greek manuscript text of John 3:3 and the literal sub-linear English under it. The common English is “if you are not generated from above you cannot understand God’s Kingdom”

Jesus’ and Nicodemus’ discussion was a confirmation of the written Word of God concerning the prophecies about the Kingdom in agreement to divine promises. To wit:

“ For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given: and the government shall be upon His shoulder --- of the increase of His government and peace there shall be no end, upon the throne of David, and upon His Kingdom---” Isaiah 9:6,7

“And the Kingdom and dominion, and the greatness of the Kingdom under the whole heaven, shall be given to the people of the saints of the Most High ---” Daniel 6:27

“--- and (Jesus) hast made us unto our God kings and priests; and we shall reign on the Earth.” Revelation 5:10
