The bread and wine of Jesus Christ at the Christian Passover Memorial

Important truth for your life now and your life everlasting
(A message for white Christians of the family of the Holy Scriptures)

1. Participating in the true Bible Passover dinner with the bread & wine memorial is a real blessing by God upon His children whom He has saved from eternal death into eternal life. God has paid for the right of His children to have eternal life by taking their sins, putting them all on His Son, Jesus Christ, and destroying those sins on the bloody cross at Christ's death. The true Passover dinner participation says "I remember and cherish this". Passover is Christian. Jewish Passover is fake with no Christ, the Lamb of God who died for you.
2. Yes, Christ died for you so that you may live forever. You either have this truth in your heart or you don't. There is no fooling God.
3. If you are one of Christ's, then your works prove that faith. Saying that you are a Christian is one thing. Anybody can say that. Doing the things that prove it is another thing altogether. This means that you trust Jesus for your eternal life, and you love to keep God's laws – both.
4. Jesus said "If you love me, keep my commandments".(John 14:15) If you are not searching the Bible to apply God's commandments to your lifestyle because you love Him, this is making a mockery of all that Christ has done for you. In this case you should never partake of the Bread & Wine at Passover or you will enter into a curse on your life. The Apostle Paul tells us, "*Whoever eats this bread and drinks this cup unworthily, is guilty of the blood of Jesus Christ*" (I Corinthians 11:27) This is no joke.
5. It's never too late to repent, come out of the deadly world system, and get right with God. He says, "*Come now, and let's reason together, says God: though your sins be as scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they be red as crimson, they shall be as wool.*" (Isaiah 1:18) The true Passover dinner is a great place to turn to God with other Christians and trust Jesus for your life. Especially in this perilous age.
