Saxon Christian Israel Feast Day Times (as figuring them on our present Gregorian calendar)

All other races and nationalities except the white Christian Israel people are permitted and encouraged to honor their heritage days. Our people are stuck with celebrating pagan days such as Christmas and Easter or worse endorsing communist hero days such as Martin Luther King day. Gathering in agreement with “like kind” strengthens the ties and bonds of brotherhood and love among a people. Is it any wonder then why white Christians are denied their heritage considering that God has given our family eight Holy Days of celebration throughout the year?

The specific original Israel solar calendar times and numbered months may be located by going to our “calendar web page” and viewing the Israelite calendar plus other related articles.

For this mini info page we will deal only with locating when to keep these family feasts as seen from our present (Gregorian) calendar. These appointed times are from the true Saxon Israel Solar Calendar and these days are fixed being stable yearly. This means that they will be on the dates and times shown below every year and will not vary from year to year as with the Jewish false system of lunar or soli-lunar times that are chaotic.

Passover meal – Just after the beginning sunset of April 2nd every year

Feast of Unleavened – 7 days running from sunset of April 3rd until sunset of April 10th

Pentecost – Sunset of May 23 until sunset of May 24th (see calendar for the 48 hr Sabbath)

Feast of Trumpets – Sunset of September 19th until sunset of September 20th

Day of Atonement (meaning “agreement”) – Sundown September 28th until sundown 29th

Feast of Tabernacles – 7 days, Sundown October 3rd until sundown October 10th

Last Great Day – Sundown October 10th until sundown October 11th

Saxon Thanksgiving – Sundown November 26th (feast technically lasts until sundown 29th)
