Regardless of the fact that multiculturalism has destroyed every great civilization to date, and that the Scriptures tell us that the Almighty Creator holds a great disdain for the globalist one world communal system, the liberal theologian in our midst still perpetuates the unnatural conclusion that "all races are the same" and therefore we need to all assimilate into one huge international commune. It does not matter to the communist visionary that God destroyed the Tower of Babel declaring it an evil experiment of the globalist "oneness doctrine" -- [Read Genesis chapter 11].

It isn't just in modern times that the social gospel theory has crept into Christianity. As far back as the middle ages we have solid evidence that theologians of the world system were hard at work debauching the word of God to promote their unnatural society of forcing all the different races of Earth to intermingle in close proximity of each other (that has led to most social woes we see today). Multiculturalism is as unnatural as trying to force lions and grizzly bears to live together in a captive environment. "And (God) hath made of one blood all nations of men for to dwell on all the face of the Earth, and hath determined the times before appointed, and the bounds of their habitation." Acts 17:26

From this, the radical leftist clergy who have infiltrated the churches teach those in their congregations that every humankind on the planet was made from one common blood by the Creator, thus validating their encouragement of multiculturalism and even interracial marriage.

However, this claim is exceedingly false. The word "blood" did not appear in any Greek text manuscript of Acts 17:26 as written by the New Testament Apostles of God. By inserting "blood" into this verse the institutional church translators have completely derailed the true intent and meaning of Acts 17:26. Below is the verse as seen in the first century sacred Greek text from the earliest manuscripts available. The sub-linear "word by word" in English makes it possible for the layman to clearly note how the ancient Greek Bible text was originally penned: [photos by "fair use" teaching, credit given]

Clearly, the word blood was later added by those having a politically-correct agenda, to the ruin of what this verse really meant. But does every English translation contain the word "blood" therein with respect to Acts 17:26? No, not at all. Some of the more literal translations retained the verse as it was in the first century Greek text. Just one example is seen below with the more accurate Rotherham Version.

25 Nor by human hands is waited upon, as though in ‡want of anything. Himself giving unto all life, and breath, and all things; 26 He made also of one every nation of men to dwell upon all the face of the earth, marking out fitting opportunities, and the bounds of their dwelling place.

Likewise, the Ferrar Fenton Version, a British Bible of 1903, astutely capitalizes the word "one", plus views the Greek/English preposition as "by" – resulting in "by One". What is the "One", or rather <u>who</u> is the "One" of Acts 17:26? To find the answer abandoned by the corporate churches, we need only let the Word of God interpret itself by cross referencing other verses to comprehend the message: precisely "God created all that there is through and by the One who is the express image of the Father,".

"But unto us there is but one God, the Father, of whom are all things, and we in Him; and <u>One</u> Master Jesus Christ, by whom are all things, and we by Him." I Cor. 8:6

"For by Him (God's dear Son)) were all things created, that are in heaven, and that are in Earth, visible and invisible, whether they be thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: all things were created by Him, and for Him." Col.1:16

The "one" of Acts 17:26 was never any reference to, or implication about, "blood" at all. It is a comment about The One who has made all men, and all nations, and all there is, namely The One who is the manifestation of God, being the One who justifies those whom He so chooses.

"--- For if through the offense of one (Adam) many be dead, much more the grace of God, and the gift by grace, which is by one man, Jesus Christ, hath abounded unto many --- For as by one man's disobedience many were made sinners, so by the obedience of One shall many be made righteous." Romans 5: 15 - 19

All the different races of people on Earth are not of one blood, and the Bible never makes that claim. This is not to imply hatred by any means, which some being conditioned by TV and Hollywood automatically assume. It is simply getting to the truth of the Holy Scriptures. Those who intend to agitate social well-being attempt to use their false claims in hopes of anarchy, thus to then "save the world" by communism. Deceptively adding to the word of God can only add to our present national problems. Let us believe what The Almighty has given us in His Word, as written by the prophets and apostles.
