A small sample of ancient pre-Christian crosses

Jesus was impaled on a *stauros*, a single pole. The churches today are mainly pagan in practice and doctrine. Do we really want to continue with the ancient heathen cross symbol? **Many other** pre-Christian heathen/pagan crosses could be shown but space does not permit. Most of them depict an origin in star or nature worship. Yes shocking, but true!

In referring to the stake upon which Christ was killed, Bullinger notes: *“It never means two pieces of timber placed across one another at any angle, but always one piece alone. Crosses were used as symbols of the Babylonian sun-god. (Christ) was put to death upon an upright stake, and not on two pieces of timber placed at any angle.”* [E.W. Bullinger, The Companion Bible, appendix 162]

“This pagan symbol, the Tau, the sign of the cross, the indisputable sign of Tammuz, the false Messiah, the mystic Tau of the Chaldeans and Egyptians – the true original form of the letter T, the initial of the name of Tammuz, the Babylonian cross, was the recognized emblem of Tammuz.” [Alexander Hislop, The Two Babylons, pages 197 – 205]

“Half Christian” Constantine’s supposed vision (312 AD) of some sort of cross in the sky is more of the astrological superimposing of star and planet worship into the corruption of Christianity. Early true Christians never used the cross as any symbol of the Savior whatsoever, and it was not until well after 500 AD that crosses appeared upon church steeples. The words “cross” and “crucified” are not to be found in the Greek New Testament manuscripts. These words were inserted into our English Bibles by later corrupt “church leaders” whose spiritual teachings were scattered with occult mystic doctrines of the East.

“In the Egyptian churches, the cross was a pagan symbol of life borrowed by the Christians and interpreted in the pagan manner.” [Encyclopedia Britannica, 11th edition, Vol. 14, pg. 273]

Not only did ancient Babylon and Egypt play a part in paganizing Christians into cross worship, the Catholic Church began its campaign of crucifix indoctrination among their multicultural (universal/catholic) congregations as far back as the 6th century AD.[Ralph Woodrow, Babylon Mystery Religion, pg. 50] Protestants may have removed Tammuz (the false Christ) from the Catholic cross crucifix but their world wide churches still worship the Tau/cross universally, and display it upon their centers of worship. We can see these temples of Baal-Tammuz on every street corner of America. They are institutions that disseminate state licensed establishment propaganda to the masses of those seeking *religion*, instead of obedience to the laws of The Everliving (Yahweh) and His son Yahshua (Jesus) the Christ of Israel. Should Bible believers be attending and supporting the pagan cross bearing churches of mainstream “Christianity” and their non-scriptural teachings of *worldly universalism* when Jesus said “ I am not sent but unto the lost sheep of the house of Israel”? But some might ask: Didn't Jesus die on the cross at Easter? No, our Savior did not. Easter itself is a pagan holiday with origins in the Chaldean Babylonian veneration of their sky goddess Ishtar. Yahshua/Jesus' death was centered around the true Israelite Passover, not at Easter commemorating Ishtar. Before Babylon, Ishtar was known by the Canaanite name of Astarte and the Hebrew Ashtoreth. Ancient mythology depicts her as the supreme female deity who had a male consort god, Tammuz, whom she killed but later resurrected, thus presenting an occult perversion of the Messiah's own death and resurrection. As the myth presents her, Ishtar could form her wings into a cross where she could fly up to the celestials. The Ishtar (Easter) winged cross goddess is seen below. Her and her resurrected consort have been memorialized with a yearly celebration for thousands of years. Ezekiel 8:14 tells us about abominations of women "weeping for Tammuz" circa 600 BC (their yearly "Easter" homage according to mythology)

← The true account of the cross at Ishtar/Easter time has been withheld from well meaning Christians. At left is a Sumerian archaeological relief of the cross-winged goddess Ishtar who resurrected her consort Tammuz (to her left). Her "cross-wings" enable her to fly among the celestial realm (star shown). Ishtar is also known as *The Queen of Heaven* in pagan religions. (Jer.44:17,18,19) Do we know of any large international religion today that worships the Queen of Heaven? And Tammuz on the pagan Tau cross?

Many other pre-Christian heathen/pagan crosses are not shown in this short study. Most are derived from an origin in heathen divination of the stars and planets in the night sky. As much as Egypt and Babylon incorporated the cross into their religions, the occult star and planet worship that Yahweh Almighty warned Israel against predates even those antediluvian nations. The Vedic religion creed (that was the precursor to Indian Hinduism) divided the night sky into four quadrants making a cross in the sky. It was from each section of the celestial cross of astrology that Vedic and later Hindu shamans interpreted the stars and planets which were supposedly in control of people's lives. Recorded history records that the sky cross quadrant superstition of Vedic astrology has existed for over 5000. Ancient pagan Greece and Rome later adopted this form of sky astrology based on celestial crosses. Below is an ancient pagan Roman coin with the sky deity Urania embossed upon it with star crosses by which astrologers would attempt to divine events and fortunes to achieve power over the Earth upon which Urania stands.



“The Royal stars of Persia are so named because roughly 5000 years ago ... they were considered to be guardians of the four corners of heaven and watchers of the directions forming a heavenly cross...” *The Four Royal Stars* --- 2013; Crystalwind oracle publishing

“Three key planets—Mercury, Saturn and Jupiter—are indicators of the individual experience on each cross. The three planets “veiled” by the Sun and Moon—Vulcan, Neptune and Uranus—also symbolize the human arena affected by that cross (material, emotional, mental). In a wholistic esoteric interpretation, these six planets focus the overall strength of a cross --.” *Esoteric astrology, a treatise on the seven rays*; Paperback – January 1, 1974

Beyond the two sample quotes listed above many other occult astrology creeds and practices testify to the same belief in divination by various views of celestial “quadrants”. Star and planet gazing wasn’t just astrology, it was a worship of star quadrants (crosses) in the sky.

Deuteronomy 4:15,19, “Take ye therefore good heed unto yourselves; --- lest thou lift up thine eyes unto heaven, and when thou seest the sun, and the moon, and the stars, even all the host of heaven, shouldest be driven to worship them, and serve them, which Yahweh thy God hath divided unto all nations under the whole heaven.”

The cross was (is) also an occult heathen carnal fertility sign with the horizontal being female and the penetrating vertical being male. The institutional churches and clergy attempt to put a spin on these well *substantiated facts* and offer lame excuses why the cross is Christian when it clearly is not, exactly as Christmas and Easter are not Christian. Well meaning Christians have been deceived.

IN CONCLUSION:

To settle the matter our Savior Himself said that He would be killed on a stauros straight pole. This should be enough testimony to end the discussion in truth.
